Pursuant to the provisions of the Law on Higher Education of the Una-Sana Canton (*Official Gazette of the Una-Sana Canton*, No. 26/24), the Decision of the Senate of the University of Bihać No. 06–1644/26 dated 30 March 2026, and the Decision of the Government of the Una-Sana Canton No. 03–02–44–725/2026 dated 17 June 2026, the University of Bihać hereby announces

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**

**for admission to the I (first) year of the I (first) cycles of study at the faculties of the University of Bihać in the 2026/2027 academic year**

**1. Admission of students to the I (first) year of the I (first) cycle of study**

The Call for Applications for admission to the I (first) year of the I (first) cycle of study in the 2026/27 academic year shall be open from 19.6.2026 to 10.7.2026 (first application period).

The Call for Applications for admission to the I (first) year of the I (first) cycle of study in the 2026/27 academic year shall be open from 31.8.2026 to 11.9.2026 (second application period).

**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

In the first year of studies in the academic 2026/27 year, candidates are enrolled in accordance with the student admission plan.

The right to participate in the Call for Applications have citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina, foreign nationals, and stateless persons who have completed an appropriate four-year secondary school in Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as candidates who completed secondary school outside Bosnia and Herzegovina, in accordance with legal regulations.

Admission and enrollment of students in the I year of studies is carried out by a special commission appointed by the competent authority of the faculty of the University of Bihać.

The selection of candidates shall be carried out on the basis of the Decision on criteria and measures for determining the order of admission of candidates for enrollment in the I year of studies at the University of Bihać, which is an integral part of this Call for Applications, as well as individual criteria of the faculties of the University of Bihać for the evaluation of grades from subjects relevant to the respective study.

The preliminary list of candidates for the first application period shall be published no later than July 13, 2026, while for the second application period it shall be published no later than September 14, 2026.

Candidates have the right to submit objections to the preliminary list within two days from the day of publication, on which the Teaching and Scientific Council of the organizational unit is obliged to make a decision.

After the expiry of the appeal period, the organizational unit publishes the final ranking list on July 16, 2026 for the first application period, and on September 17, 2026 for the second application period. The decision of the Teaching and Scientific Council is final.

Applications with the required documentation for enrollment in the I year of the I cycle of studies may be submitted at the premises of the faculty to which candidates apply or submitted electronically/online via the internet platform <https://prijave.unbi.ba>

The faculties of the University of Bihać shall provide full information on their notice boards and websites regarding the place and time of submission of documents for the Call for Applications, as well as information about the possibilities and method of electronic/online application via the internet platform <https://prijave.unbi.ba>

For application to the Call for Applications for enrollment in the I year of the I cycle of studies, the candidate is required to submit to the official premises of the faculty to which they apply or upload via the internet platform (if the application is electronic/online) the following documents:

- 1) Application to the Call for Applications or completed electronic/online application
- 2) Original certificates/certified copies of completed secondary school (four-year duration) in Bosnia and Herzegovina, or corresponding nostrified documents for candidates who completed secondary school outside Bosnia and Herzegovina
- 3) Original diploma/certified copy of completed secondary school
- 4) Birth certificate
- 5) Certificate of citizenship
- 6) Other documents relevant for determining the number of points according to the criteria

Candidates may apply to two faculties/study program at the University of Bihać. If the application is submitted at the official premises, original documents are submitted to the faculty/study program of primary choice, while certified copies are submitted to the faculty/study program of alternative choice.

It is also possible to apply to two faculties/study programs at the University of Bihać via the internet platform.

After completion of the admission procedure and publication of the ranking list of candidates, admitted candidates enroll at the selected faculty of the University of Bihać with original documents.

Applications submitted after the deadline, as well as incomplete applications, shall not be taken into consideration.

For all study programs at the University of Bihać that do not admit the planned number of candidates in the first application period, admission of students shall be carried out in accordance with the Decision of the Government of the Una-Sana Canton No. 03-02-44-725/2026 of 17 June 2026, also in the second application period.

The right to participate in the Call for Applications in the second application period is granted to all candidates who did not apply in the first application period and who meet the requirements of the Call for Applications.

The Decision on criteria and measures for determining the order of admission of candidates for enrollment in the I (first) year of the I (first) cycle of studies shall be published on the faculty website.

Enrollment of students in the I (first) year of the I (first) cycle of studies in the 2026/27 academic year shall be carried out as follows:

## **DECISION**

### **on criteria and measures for determining the order of admission of candidates for enrollment in the I year of the I cycle of studies at the University of Bihać**

#### **Article 1**

This Decision establishes common criteria and measures for scoring and enrollment of candidates in the I year of the I cycle of studies at the University of Bihać.

#### **Article 2**

Ranking of candidates and admission of students to the I year of studies shall be based on the number of points achieved by the candidate:

**I.** At faculties of the University of Bihać where an entrance exam is provided, based on:

- general success,
- success in individual subjects relevant to the study program,
- results achieved on the entrance exam,
- results achieved in competitions in relevant subjects and in top-level sports,
- special recognition “Student of the Generation”.

**II.** At faculties where there is no entrance exam, based on:

- general success,
- success in individual subjects relevant to the study program,
- results achieved in competitions in relevant subjects and in top-level sports,
- special recognition “Student of the Generation”.

#### **Article 3**

The number of points based on general success is a maximum of 35 and is calculated by multiplying the average grade from all subjects in all school years (excluding final exam grades), rounded to two decimal places, by 7.

#### **Article 4**

The number of points based on performance in individual subjects relevant to the chosen study program is a maximum of 15, and it is calculated by multiplying the average grade from all relevant subjects—rounded to two decimal places—by 3.

The list of subjects relevant to each study program/department will be published by the faculties of the University of Bihać on their notice boards and on their website.

#### **Article 5**

The list of subjects for the entrance exam by departments and study programs, as well as the method of evaluation and scoring, shall be published on the notice boards and websites of the faculties.

The maximum number of points that a candidate can achieve on the entrance exam is 30 points.

### **Article 6**

The number of points based on results achieved in competitions in subjects relevant to the respective study program, as well as results achieved in top-level sports, is a maximum of 6.

Based on these criteria, the candidate receives the following number of points: for winning one of the first three places at international, national, and cantonal competitions in knowledge of scientific (professional) disciplines relevant to the study program, 3 points.

For outstanding results achieved in top-level sports, 3 points.

The list of subjects, i.e. scientific (professional) disciplines that are scored on this basis, shall be published by the faculties on their notice boards and websites.

### **Article 7**

A candidate who is the holder of the special recognition “Student of the Generation” receives 10 points on this basis.

### **Article 8**

The minimum number of points that a candidate must achieve on the entrance exam shall be determined by the faculty.

### **Article 9**

The procedure for implementation of this Decision is carried out by a commission appointed by the faculty.

At faculties where an entrance exam is taken, the commission is obliged to ensure the confidentiality of examination materials and other relevant documentation.

After summing the points for each candidate individually, on all bases from this Decision, the commission prepares a ranking list of all candidates and a list of admitted candidates, and after it is adopted by the Teaching and Scientific Council of the faculty, within the deadline defined in the Call for Applications, publishes it on the notice board and website.

On the published preliminary ranking list, candidates may submit a written objection to the Teaching and Scientific Council of the faculty within 2 days after publication of the list.

After the expiry of the appeal period, the organizational unit publishes the final ranking list within the deadline defined by the Call for Applications.

The decision of the Teaching and Scientific Council is final.

### **Article 10**

Faculties of the University of Bihać that do not admit the planned number of candidates in the first application period shall conduct a second application period in accordance with the published Call for Applications.

### **Article 11**

Candidates who, in accordance with this Call for Applications, are admitted to a faculty of the University of Bihać, for enrollment in the I year of studies, in addition to submitted documents, also submit:

- enrollment form, semester form, and ŠV form,
- student index (INDEX),
- medical certificate,
- proof of payment of tuition fees.

### **Article 12**

Under equal conditions from the Criteria, priority is given to:

- children of war fighters/defenders of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
  - children of disabled war veterans, children of martyrs and fallen and missing fighters/defenders and deceased disabled war veterans,
  - children of organizers of resistance,
  - children of veteran first fighters,
  - children of prisoners of war,
  - children of holders of the highest war decorations.
- (All in accordance with applicable legal regulations governing this area.)
